

Holy Family School Volunteer Opportunities

Each family is required to complete 20 Angel Points as part of the registration/tuition agreement. As part of this agreement, families are required to complete 3 Angel Points as “in-school” points. The purpose of the 3 “in-school” Angel Point requirement is to have parents and extended family members assist with on-site events and activities. Please note, any “in-school” points require Holy Family Clearances. We are usually short on this type of help and it is also beneficial for your children to see their family members actively involved at Holy Family School.

Note to Chair/Co-Chair's:

Each Chairperson or Co-chairperson of an event and/or fundraiser at Holy Family School will be sent a detailed letter from the Fundraising/Co-Chair Coordinator prior to the date of their event. The letter will include the form for submission of VAP hours, and a timeline to follow for recording Volunteer Angel Point hours. This letter will also include any necessary information that has been gathered over the years to run and organize your event, including contact and vendor information if applicable. Our intention is to streamline the information passed down from previous Chairpersons and compile it in one place, so that each time a new Chairperson or Co- Chairperson take over an event and/ or fundraiser he or she has all the tools necessary to run it successfully. One kind request when you come in to volunteer:

We kindly request that **ANY** time you come in to help **IN** the school, you go through the front office, sign-in on our visitor log, get a name tag, and sign-out as you leave the building. This is not only for our children's safety but also for your own. In the case of an emergency and the building requires to be evacuated, the police and fire department need to account for all individuals that have entered the building.

Holy Family School Volunteer Opportunities

Why does the school need volunteers?

Just about every event throughout the school year requires help from volunteers. The parents of Holy Family have traditionally provided the backbone of the volunteer force which makes these events possible. This is also an opportunity given by our school to stay involved in our children's emotional and academic development within the school environment.

Is there a benefit or reward to volunteering?

The rewards for this parental involvement through volunteering are many. Your child will see you as an active participant in the school, whether being there or helping out from home. Most of us remember how we enjoyed having our parents help our school, which is something many schools just do not have any more. So, we are very lucky this is offered to us. You can reach your goal of 20 Volunteer Angel Points easily and have fun doing it.

Who can help?

Family members from parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, etc. that have full clearances can help. Clearance forms can be downloaded from our website <http://www.holyfamilynazareth.com> under forms. They are named: "Volunteer Clearance Packet". Forms will also be available for you at the school and parish office.

What if you work?

We offer working parents the opportunity to do things from home, help sell cash cards during weekend masses, help at our Parish Festival, send food/paper items into school for events & so much more.

How will you know what opportunities are available?

We will keep you updated periodically of upcoming events & volunteer opportunities via flyers sent home, emails, E-News, Facebook, and notices posted on the website.

How can I earn the required 3 In School Event Volunteer Angel Points (VAPs)?

You can earn these 3 points by volunteering at an event approved for the In School Event VAPs. One hour of volunteer = 1 VAP. Many of these events are listed below and will be added to/updated during the school year. A number of these events are in the evening or on the weekends, enabling working parents to easily complete the 3 "In-School" required VAPs.

List of Some Available Opportunities for Volunteering: These are subject to change at any time:

Lunch Duty: 11:00 am to 1:00 pm. Help is always needed to serve lunch and maintain safety in the cafeteria. Call the school at 610-759-5642 and ask for Francine Niemira or Kathy Unger to schedule a day to volunteer or just show up to help (clearances required). *Approved for In School Event VAPS.

Monthly - Weekend Hours:

Cash Card Sales: Before and after weekend masses (Sat. 5pm, Sun. 7 am, 9 am, 11 am). You can volunteer once a month or whatever works best for you and your family. Call the parish office at 610-759-0870. *Approved for In School Event VAPS.

Major Weekend Events:

Holy Family Parish Festival (July): Day hours for set up and break-down, evening hours on the weekend to work the actual festival. A large amount of volunteers are needed, since there are many stations and hours to cover.

Things You Can Do From Home: Sending baked goods or bought food, paper products for events held throughout the year. This is handled by the Hospitality Committee, and other committees, etc. (depending on the event). There are many other opportunities available to do from home. Please pay attention to flyers, our website, E-news, and emails.

School Events: *Approved for In School Event VAPs.

Field Trips: During school hours. Room parents or teachers will contact families to arrange for you to chaperone a trip. This is also up to the teacher's discretion as to how many chaperones will be allowed on a specific trip.

Scholastic Book Fair (Fall and Spring): Mostly during school hours. Help is needed to set up, break down and assist the children in purchasing books.

Christmas Decorating of the school (December): During/after school hours. A fun way to bring the Christmas spirit to the children. (Putting decorations away will be needed in January.)

Santa Workshop (December): During school hours. Help is needed to set up, break down and assist the younger children with the purchase of gifts for their loved ones.

Christmas Show (December): PM hours. Food items and refreshments will be collected by the Hospitality Committee. Help is needed that evening to set up the food items, clean up and assist by replenishing the food/drink items. Refreshments will not be served until after the show.

Open House (Last Sunday in January): Food/paper products/drink items will be collected by the Hospitality Committee. Help will be needed to give a tour/guide to families that wish to visit the school campus.

Art Show (April/May): School hours. Set up and break down.

Grandparents Day (May): AM school hours. A large number of volunteers will be needed for many different things. Many opportunities are available.

Spring Fundraiser - "Race for Education" (April): During school hours and at home. A large number of helpers will be needed for set up, giving water to children, break down, write thank you notes, etc.

Field Day (May/June): During school hours. Large number of volunteers needed to assist each station.

Mission Carnival (May): During school hours. Many helpers needed for each station, set up and break down.

Hospitality for Kindergarten/New Student Orientation (May): During school hours. Help will be needed to host and set up refreshments for parents of new incoming students in kindergarten and other grades.

Fundraisers: Coordinate one of our many fundraisers throughout the year.

Barnes and Noble Night (December): **PM hours.** A large number of volunteers are needed to work several stations and activities.

Family Events: (PM Hours): Game Night, Kids Night Out, Trunk or Treat, and many other events held throughout the year. A large number of volunteers are needed to make each event a success.
